

Obria Group v. Ferguson

Case Name: Obria Group, Inc., and Obria Medical Clinics PNW v. Robert Ferguson

Case Action: Case filed on November 29th, 2023.

Significance: Whether the government can target and harass pregnancy centers for their pro-life views.



Background:

The Obria Group is a network of pro-life medical clinics that provide comprehensive and compassionate care, operating over 20 clinics across several states. In May 2022, Washington Attorney General Bob Ferguson issued demand letters to Obria Group and Obria Pacific Northwest, purportedly to investigate "possible" deceptive marketing, particularly related to abortion pill reversal, as well as "possible" unfair collection and use of consumer data. The letters did not list any consumer or patient complaints or any evidence of a violation of the law. The AG demanded that they dig up 13 years of documentation including information regarding the identities of their contractors, volunteers, and tax preparers, board meeting notes, and much more. The AG's actions are outrageous, inappropriate, and unconstitutional—and many of the requested documents do not pertain to the investigation of so-called "deceptive" advertising and collection of user data. Alliance Defending Freedom filed a lawsuit against the Washington AG on behalf of Obria Group and Obria Pacific Northwest to allow pro-life medical clinics to continue serving women, men, and children without unjust government interference or harassment.

Key Points
